The School Counselor is a member of GISB's health and safety team and provides quality Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) to all of our students.

YOUR TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develop and implement an all-encompassing counseling plan.
- Provide support services to individual students, small groups, and whole classrooms.
- Develop and implement proactive programming for students and staff on social-emotional and mental health topics in grades pre kindergarten through 12th grade.
- Lead weekly remote social-emotional class lessons in grades 1-4.
- Provide professional development to train teachers in SEL and collaborate with faculty and administration on social-emotional and behavioral student needs.
- Build relationships with families that support students' academic, emotional, and behavioral needs.
- Provide referral to and serve as liaison between the school and outside agencies and clinicians as needed to support students.
- Be aware of cultural differences when working with students and parents.
- Maintain relevant documentation for students and consult with the Director of Health and Wellness, Special Education Teacher, and College Advisor, as necessary.
